Data Analysis: Our Building Leadership Team reviewed the following data and identified our celebrations, as well as our opportunities for improvement.

Celebrations:

- 87% of students met expected or higher than expected growth in iReady reading
- 89% of students met expected or higher than expected growth in math
- Met projected proficiency and expected growth in both Reading and Math on IAR

Opportunities for Improvement:

- The vocabulary domain in iReady had the lowest percentage of students meeting proficiency (63%)
- ACCESS scores indicate that only 22% of EL students are above the developing range within the speaking domain
- On the 5EssentialsSurvey, 72% of students reported that their school peers treat each other with respect.

Student Performance Target Goals

- 1. Greater than 84% of students will demonstrate expected or higher than expected growth in All Subjects (ELA, Reading and Math) according to the ECRA Overall Growth Summary.
- 2. Outperform our IAR projected proficiency target identified in the ECRA Spring IAR Projected Proficiency Report.
- 3. On the District Strategic Plan Survey, at least 75% of students will agree or strongly agree that their social and emotional needs are being addressed.

Current Status and Next steps

- 1. Increase student vocabulary through reading, writing, and speaking in all content areas.
 - a. Increase professional development for teachers on vocabulary strategies
 - b. Connect vocabulary strategies to identified language arts standards across content areas
 - c. Monitor implementation of strategies across content areas
 - d. Implement building wide communication log with vocabulary focus
- 2. Implement common SEB time to increase students' sense of belonging and community. This will allow mixed K-5 groups to collaborate in building-wide SEB activities focused on our mission.
