- 5. Use best instructional practices to meet students' needs while holding high expectations for students encouraging **self-empowerment** (Portrait of a Graduate).
- 6. Through professional development and team meetings, provide staff with learning about the importance of building relationships with students and parents. Follow up with actionable opportunities to grow those relationships.
